The Tudor Monarchs

- Edward was nine years old when Henry VIII died; a Council of Regency was established by Henry's Will, headed by Edward's uncle, Edward Seymour, Duke of Somerset
- By March 1547, Seymour was ruling without the Council
- Seymour committed England to a disastrous war against Scotland
- In 1549, Seymour was overthrown by

have been decommissioned long before the Tudors Elton's top-down or center-out approach to local administration during the mid-Tudor era is shared by several historians, notably John Guy In his survey on Tudor England, Guy takes a viewpoint similar to Elton's ideology about the mid-Henrician years and applies it to the Tudor era as a whole

Henry VI created divisions within the nobility as they vied to control a vulnerable ruler His breakdown in 1453 led to the protectorate of Richard, Duke of York, but despite Henry's recovery in 1455, civil war broke out between the Lancastrian and Yorkist factions resulting in the first reign of the Yorkist King Edward VI (1461-70)
